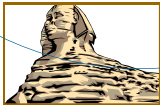

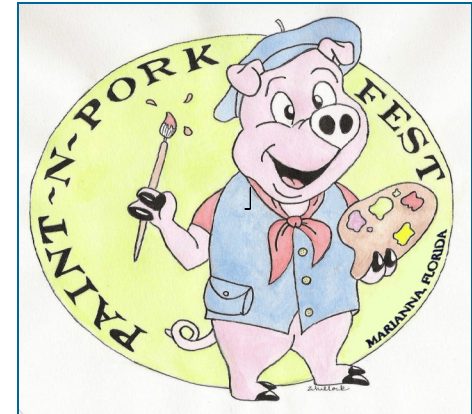

JOIN US FOR FOOD AND FUN

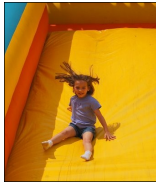
Join us for two days of family-oriented fun! This annual event has something for all...

Our Memphis in May BBQ Cook-Off offers three categories: whole hog, shoulder, and ribs.

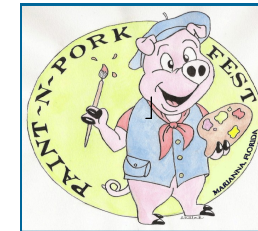

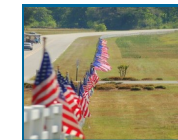
